with transfer of technology from Naval Group. Recently on 28th September 2019, Naval Group has been proud witness to the successful delivery of *INS Khanderi*, the second of P75 SCORPENE®-class submarine, which achieves our vision to strengthen strategic partnership in India.

Since 2006, Naval Group had been involved in P28 project, for delivery of raft mounted gearboxes with high military stealth features. This was one of the major indigenous manufacturing achievements for Naval Group India as 6 out of 8 complex gearboxes were manufactured by Indian partner at Walchandnagar. The extra ordinary stealth of these indigenous platforms equipped with best in class propulsions stand out yet again as good example of our successful industrial collaboration in India.
